

John Curtice is Professor of Politics at the University of Strathclyde and Senior Research Fellow at NatCen Social Research. He is one of Britain's leading psephologists and is the current President of the British Polling Council. He is an expert on electoral behaviour, political and social attitudes. He is widely known for his accurate predictive analysis of exit polls in recent British elections including the referendum on Scottish independence.

Professor Curtice was educated at Truro School and Magdalen College, Oxford where he read Politics, Philosophy and Economics, and later transferred to Nuffield College as a postgraduate.
